ORDER UNDER SECTION 7(1) OF THE RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.

Shri Sh. Tripurari Sharan, F-12, Vasundhara State, NH-33, Dimna Chowk, Mango, Jamshedpur, East Singhbhum, Jharkhand-831018 has made an application dated 16.06.2014 addressed to the CPIO, O/O Commissioner of Central Excise, Ahmedabad-III, Gujarat which was received by this office on 04.08.2014. The applicant is seeking i) the number and details of vacancies communicated to the Staff Selection Commission by the Office of the Collector, Central Excise, Patna for the Inspectors of Central Excise, Income Tax Etc. Examination, 1989 conducted on 20.08.1989 along with copy of all the letters/communications between the Staff Selection Commission and the Office of the Collector, Central Excise, Patna for the said examination and appointment of Inspector of Central Excise in Bihar. ii) The merit list of all the selected candidates on the basis of written test and interview in Inspectors of Central Excise, Income Tax Etc. Examination, 1989 iii) State-wise year of joining of the inspector of Central Excise on the basis of written test and interview in Inspectors of Central Excise, Income Tax etc. Examination 1989. iv) the reasons on record for delay of seven months in sending the offer of appointment to candidates recommended for appointment after publication of final result on 11.08.1990, whereas column 17c of the Proforma for sending requisition to the SSC clearly stipulated that candidates nominated against these vacancies shall be given appointment within a period of three months from the date of nomination. The offer of appointment was sent by the additional Collector, Central Excise, Patna in March, 1991 via file No.II(3)108/ET/90 dated 11.03.1991 after seven months of publication of final result on 11.08.1990 in the Employment News.

3. The information regarding point No. (i) to (iv) are not pertain to this office.

4. If the applicant is aggrieved with the information supplied, an appeal against this decision may be preferred in terms of Section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 to Shri Milind Gawai, Appellate Authority, Additional Commissioner, Central Excise, 2nd Floor, Customs House, Navrangpura, Ahmedabad within a period of 30 days from the receipt of the order.
